



Installing the Weaver Leaver

- Step 1 Determine which direction the Weaver Leaver will pivot when installed. This is done by raising the dinghy on the davits to a vertical position and then observing which direction the outboard will need to pivot. The Weaver Leaver should be centered on the transom.
- **Step 2** Once the proper alignment of the Weaver Leaver has been determined, bolt the Weaver Leaver to the transom using 5/16" X 3" carriage bolts and plastic shims, if needed.
























Weaver Leaver Parts Description




The **Weaver Leaver** in the closed position. The outboard has been secured and is ready for use.



Prior to raising the inflatable utilizing **Weaver Snap Davits**, the **Weaver Leaver** opened and the outboard pivoted horizontal.





Extra stability is gained by clipping the adjustable rod to the **Weaver Davit** head or pad eye.




Standard

For inflatables with a transom above the tubes to 4" below.









Model 3

For inflatables with a transom that is 4" to 6" below the top of the tubes.








Pad Eye
